ANNUAL MEETING OF THE PENNSYLVANIA GEOGRAPHICAL SOCIETY

The Pennsylvania Geographical Society and the Department of Geography and Geosciences at Salisbury University extend a warm welcome to their campus in Salisbury Maryland for the 2023 Annual Meeting on Friday, 3 November 2023.

REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN! The meeting will be held on the second floor of the Commons Dining Hall on the University Campus. Parking will be provided in the lot adjacent to the meeting venue. Presentations are limited to 15 minutes with five minutes for questions. Abstracts (for papers and posters) are limited to 200 words and should be submitted during registration. Posters will be on display all day during the meeting. Please visit the PGS website for poster size restrictions. Posters must be mounted in such a way that they may be displayed on an easel, which the PGS will provide. Abstract submissions will not be accepted after 20 October 2023.

This year's Distinguished Geographer and Guest Speaker is **Suzanne McArdle** from the Cartographic Services Branch, Geography Division, United States Census Bureau.

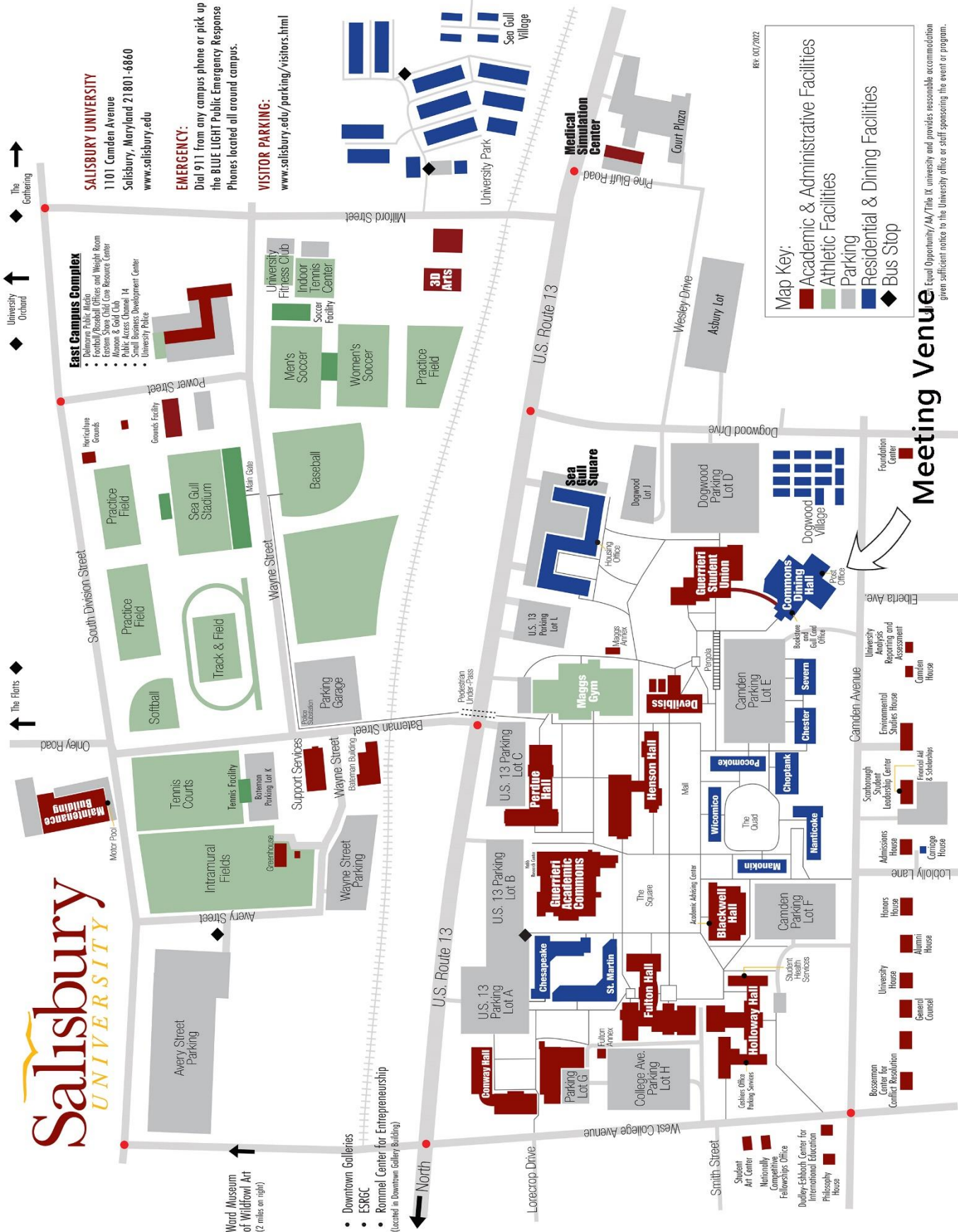
Discounted rooms are available for Thursday, 2/11 and Friday, 3/11
